## Ladies and Gentlemen:

As you likely know, I am the court-appointed Receiver for the Wisconsin Funeral Trust. Over the past several months, the Wisconsin Funeral Directors Association ("WFDA") and I, together with the Wisconsin Department of Justice, have negotiated an agreement that will, in part, provide a safe harbor for funeral homes from further claims relating to the Trust.

The attached Notice describes that agreement. Please read it. I also enclose the documents requesting court approval, and the actual negotiated agreement.

I believe this settlement is an important step in ensuring that both funeral homes and depositors are treated fairly.

You are not required to enter into this agreement. However, if the Court approves this agreement and you opt not to enter into it, you no longer will be safe from claims from depositors or class action lawyers, or claims in this receivership. The deadline for entering into the agreement is September 30, 2013.
